How to Make Halloween Safe for Kids



- Discuss Halloween safety tips with all of your children, no matter what age they are.
- When you're out trick-or-treating, only visit well-lit areas and stay on porches rather than entering people's homes.
- If they're out with other kids, attach their names and addresses inside their costumes.
- To prevent falls and other injuries, make sure your child's costume fits properly and is no longer than his/her ankles. Use makeup or face paint as opposed to masks that might block their vision.
- Make sure to go through ALL of the candy before they indulge themselves.
- Check the candy's packaging. The candy packaging should be smooth, clean, unwrinkled and appear fresh. Look for any tears, rips, holes or chewed edges in the wrapper, which could indicate the candy was tampered with or was gnawed on by rats. While you're at it, look for an expiration date if one exists. This ensures the candy has not been sitting around rotting in someone's cupboard for years. If something doesn't seem right, take the candy out of the wrapper and either cut it in half to make sure the center has nothing in it, or taste a piece of it to make sure it is just candy.
