

## DYSPORT



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### What does it do?

It treats wrinkles in the forehead, neck, and "crow's feet."

### How does it work?

It works by blocking the chemical signal from the nerve that causes the muscle to contract. This then blocks the movement of specific muscles in the face and neck preventing the skin from being folded and therefore minimizing and preventing wrinkles.

### How many treatments are needed for maximal results?

Results may be seen within days following the treatment. An enhancement may be necessary 10 days after initial procedure to achieve best results.

### How long does it take to see results?

Patients typically see diminished movement after one treatment.

### How long do results last?

Visible results can last up to 4 to 6 months. With continued treatment, results may be more lasting.

### Is it painful?

Minimal discomfort is noted upon each injection site. .

### Is there any downtime afterwards?

There is no downtime required. Rarely bruising may occur and will resolve over a few days.

### Who cannot have this procedure?

Patients with open skin lesions at the proposed injection sites, patients with neurological disorders: myasthenia gravis, or Lambert-Eaton syndrome.
